Your application form is central to the shortlisting and selection process. This guidance is intended to enhance your chance of success. Please note that CVs will not be accepted as applications unless stated otherwise on our website.

Completing the application

- Read through the job description carefully and relate your skills, knowledge and experience to the responsibilities of the post as fully as possible, providing evidence based on work or other activities.
- The person specification outlines the essential requirements you must meet in order to be selected for interview and appointment. You should therefore address your application to these criteria, demonstrating how your skills, knowledge and experience are related to the role's requirements.

- The King's Fund's values are an additional consideration for your application so please bear these in mind alongside the job description and person specification.
- Any information that you wish the short-listing panel to see should be included in the application form or in an attached extra document. Please note that emails are not sent to short-listing panels.
- Please complete the form fully in black ink or typescript.
- Applications received after the closing date will not be considered.

Submitting your application by email

Please email as a Microsoft Word document to recruitment@kingsfund.org.uk. Please make sure you use your own name as its file-name (e.g. John Smith.doc) before attaching it to your email, and use the job title as the subject heading of your email.
