Organisations are then invited to take part in the GSK IMPACT Awards Network. It connects past GSK IMPACT Award winners both online and at meetings, to get and give support, share best practice and continue their professional development. The Development Programme and Network, valued at an average of £13,500 for each organisation, is funded by GSK and hosted by The King's Fund.
