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### GSK IMPACT Awards: frequently asked questions

#### **Our charity has been running for less than three years – would we be eligible?**

To be eligible your organisation needs to have been operating for at least three years by Wednesday 19 August 2026, the deadline for stage one applications, and be a registered charity by that date. It does not need to have been a registered charity for three years. We will ask for your charity registration number at the start of the application form and may ask for a copy of its constitution to confirm this.

#### **Our charity's annual income is slightly more than £3 million – could we apply?**

To be eligible your organisation's total annual income in your most recent accounts needs to be between £150,000 and £3 million – if it is more than this upper income threshold then it is not eligible. If it is under £150,000 then you may be eligible to apply for the GSK Community Health Programme.

#### **Some of our charity's work is with communities abroad – are we eligible to apply?**

To be eligible to apply your organisation needs to be a registered charity, located and targeting community health needs in the UK (community can be defined as a geographical community or a community of interest).

#### **We run a health project for a large charity – are we eligible to apply?**

We are interested in the work of your whole charity and how this supports community health and wellbeing. If your application only focuses on your project, it would not be shortlisted. If your charity's annual income is more than £3 million it is not eligible to apply.

#### **Are community interest companies (CICs) eligible to apply?**

No, CICs and other organisations that are not registered charities are not eligible. Organisations need to be registered charities in the UK to be eligible for this programme.

#### **We have a board of five trustees and three of them are related. Are we eligible?**

No, as the trustees are the most accountable people in the organisation, we would consider that if most of the trustees are related that the organisation is not eligible to apply.

#### **We have paid staff who are also trustees. Are we eligible?**

No, if you have paid staff who are also trustees then your organisation would not be eligible. This is because there is not sufficient separation of governance between the trustees who govern the charity and the paid workers who report to the trustees.

### Questions about the application portal

#### **Registering your organisation and contact details for the first time**

When you log on to the application portal for the first time, you will need to register your organisation and contact details. By registering, you will become the main contact for your application, so please ensure your details are kept up to date. If your details change, you can update them by clicking on **Your Account** and selecting **Your details**.

#### **I'm trying to register my charity and its name is not appearing in the search bar?**

The list of registered UK charities is updated regularly, but if you cannot find your charity name and number here, it can be entered manually. When entering your organisation's details manually, you will be asked for your organisation's 'No.\identifier'. Please enter your registered UK charity number in this field.

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### How do I print and save a PDF of my application form?

Log in to the application portal, go to the **Dashboard**, and click on **View your applications**. Open the application you wish to print or save as a PDF. Click **Expand view** in the top right corner of the application form. The **Print Form** option will then appear. When you click **Print Form**, your printer settings will open. From here, you can either print your application or select 'save as PDF'.
