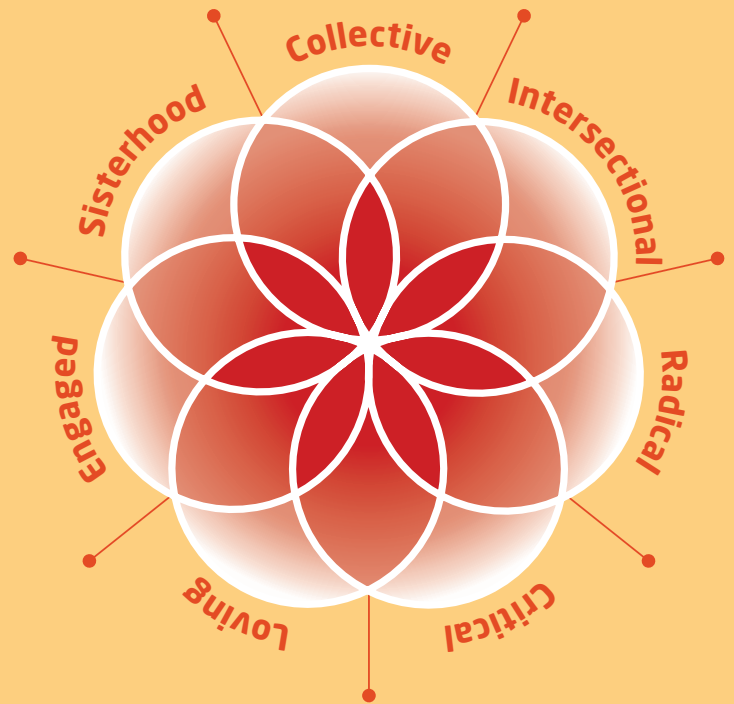

Leadership development for women

Circles is a 12-month programme that will start in September 2024. This programme is organised around four seasons of work - person, system, context and source (based on the Transforming Experience Framework developed at The Grubb Institute).

The cohort will be made up of around 45 women and the majority of your learning will be delivered online. The core quarterly commitment for learners is two days' participation covering:

- three half-day workshops with guest speakers/facilitators (via Zoom)
- two 90-minute facilitated learning reviews with The King's Fund faculty (via Zoom).

Other commitments over the course of the year include:

- participation in an opening and closing event at The King's Fund (in person)
- participation in a 90-minute quarterly 'community-building roulette' with up to five other participants (online)
- a one-to-one coaching/goal-setting session with The King's Fund faculty, lasting 90 minutes (online)
- self-directed engagement in and consumption of asynchronous learning materials
- ongoing personal journaling
- contributing to a cohort 'yearbook'.
